

ANTIOCH COLLEGE ID CARDS

All students, faculty, and staff are provided with an Antioch College ID Card, the official ID card of the college.

To obtain an ID Card, students must be accepted for admission and registered for classes. The student then must have his/her photo taken by the Public Safety Office, located in Pennell House on the First Floor. Faculty and staff are also issued Antioch College ID Cards.

An ID card is required for access to the classrooms and the residence halls as well as the library. Public Safety staff will not grant you access to buildings unless you show your ID Card.

Lost, stolen, or damaged ID cards should be reported to the Public Safety Department [937-776-0660](tel:937-776-0660) immediately. Replacement cards are obtained through Public Safety for a fee of \$15 and will be charged to your student account.

The ID must be carried at all times and presented upon request by a college official including Public Safety staff.

Any student using an Antioch College ID Card improperly or loaning his/her ID to anyone is in violation of college policy.
